Yet in the busyness of our days, we can hear Jesus' gentle whisper, inviting us to come away from the hustle and bustle and be with Him.

When we begin to make room in our life for true prayer, even though it is far from convenient, amazing things will happen. Life will become fruitful instead of frustrating. Even though the responsibilities and demands of our life will not change, we might not rush around in a stressful frenzy because we now have supernatural strength, which we gained through true prayer, to tackle daily challenges calmly and joyfully.

With prayer, any defeating and overwhelming perspective will be replaced with a victorious, conquering one. We can learn the truth of the verse, "For apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5b). I have come to realize that I cannot truly thrive in any area of my life unless I'm spending purposeful time in God's presence on a regular basis. 
PRAYER IS R.E.A.L!

Prayer is Responsive, Effective, Applicable and Leverage. Prayer is essential for our Christian growth! The Layman's Bible Dictionary defines prayer as communication with God; an active interchange with specific components that produce results. If we want prayer to be R.E.A.L. in our life and to produce results, then we must saturate our life with it. As we begin saturating our mind, body and soul with prayer, we begin developing an "always-natural" occurrence (or presence of God) in our life; resulting in an automatic conversation with God in a close and natural way. It's like breathing and blinking our eyes. It is something that we do without effort or thought; but without either, our quality of life would be missing a critical element of our existence; ending in death. The words, Responsive, Effective, Applicable and Leverage produce lasting results in our lives. Here's how.

Prayer is **RESPONSIVE**. It is one of the ways God uses prayer to accomplish His will. When God says, "I'm going to do this, and the way by which I'm going to do this is through prayer." He is about to exercise His responsiveness. The following is an example of how God responds to His people through prayer. But note there are some expectations of His people when He (God) responds. These are not un-realistic expectations because they are clearly explained in the Scriptures. So, here is the response God gives Solomon, after He hears Solomon's prayer (as recorded in 2 Chronicles). God says,



Solomon knew that to fulfill his purpose in life, he needed a response from God to affirm his calling and his destiny to build the Temple. Solomon prayed for a response and because God was pleased with Solomon's request, God responded. This was a Praise Moment for Solomon.

Prayer is **EFFECTIVE** and expectant. Yes, the dynamics of prayer received are a mystery because we are not with God when He answers or deliberates how (and when) He chooses to respond. Nevertheless, in preparing for God to answer, we formulate our responses to answered prayer as prescribed by the prophets and other witnesses of the Bible. We respond with the hope as written by James. He says in Chapter 5:16, "The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective." He also says, "You do not have, because you do not ask God." So, will our prayers move God or change His mind to act? I cannot answer this question; but this I do know; God has a plan for the future of this world and for us. God's plans are perfect. So His will is perfect also. So we pray believing that our prayers will get answered.

Prayer is **APPLICABLE**. Jesus has promised to supply us with all our needs according to His riches in Glory. In other words, He gives us what we need in order for us to do what He sent us here to do. Think of how applicable answered prayer changed a situation; how answered prayer arrived just in time to avoid a disaster; how applicable answered prayer removed an obstacle that seemed to difficult to move. We trust that whatever we honestly need, God will supply and it is applicable for that moment. Amen.

Prayer is **LEVERAGE**. It is the influence we have that multiplies the outcome of the efforts of our prayer. Our leverage comes as we strengthen our relationship with God. When we strengthen our relationship with God, we have the privilege (as believers) to walk right into God's presence and to plead to Him to help others. It's not that our prayer may change what is going to happen but that, in God's plan for the future of the world, He includes our prayers as factors that have an impact on the shaping of events. So, Men of God, continue to pray, continue to abide by Paul's direction in 1 Timothy 2:1-2, he urges, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone-for kings and all those in authority, that we may live in peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. We need to pray for our leaders, beginning with prayer for our Bishop, his family and the families and future of Truth Revealed International Ministries, and extending to local, national and world leaders.

A DISCIPLINED PRAYER LIFE LEADS TO A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Praying publicly is something I have struggled with in the past. I pray while walking, driving, gardening-anywhere, but I had avoided praying openly in churches, and I feared prayer meetings. My anxiety over praying publicly originated with what I thought was the correct way to pray. However, my fears subsided a couple years ago when I realized that the long stream of repetitious words and catchphrases some seems to have committed to memory-which can seem superficial and a way to look holy-is not the "model prayer," or a style I need to adapt. Now when I pray, I tell God what's on my heart, whether it's personal, family, or community. Sometimes it's a short prayer, other times it's long. And there have been times when I was so burdened that I would find myself stretched out before Him with no words, only groaning and tears.


Our Bishop recently called for corporate fasting and praying with a variety of request to present to God. In 2 Chronicles 6:19-42, we see where Solomon led the people in prayer with a similar intent, which is in alignment with "The Lord's Prayer" in John 17. This prayer is the model for intercessory prayers, which Bishop has been encouraging.

Wikipedia defines prayer as an invocation or act that seeks to activate a rapport with a deity, an object of worship, or a spiritual entity through deliberate communication. This seems applicable to me. There is perhaps no other act of worship more important in a believers' life than communicating with God on a daily basis, and yet for many of us, it is an inconvenience. Before His ascension, Christ prayed for Himself, His disciples and all believers in the world. So privately or publicly, individually or corporately, we must cling to God earnestly in prayer. He invites us to come boldly [with confidence] unto the throne of grace (Hebrew 4:16), and as His children, we do not go impress Him, or as beggars looking for scraps, but seated at His table in fellowship making our request known to a loving and generous Father.

The disciples recognized the significance of prayer from following and observing Jesus's own prayer life. They

had seen him slipped away on several occasions to pray, sometimes all through the night. Hence, they asked Jesus to teach them to pray (Luke 11:1). After observing Christ, the disciples had figured out that if they could develop a solid prayer life, they would be able to accomplish their own mission after Christ departure.

Christ warns: "When you pray, do not keep babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him (Matthew 6:7-8). However, we must be careful because in a drive-through, fast food society, it is easy, or at least tempting to reduce our interactions with God to the same kind of quick service mentality. Nehemiah-who prayed even while talking to others-teaches us that spontaneous prayers could be as powerful as in-depth prayers because God is always present and He hears every prayer. Still, we should not discount lengthy prayers because the reason Nehemiah could so confidently go to God anywhere and at anytime was because he had spent time with Him. In other words, he had built an intimate relationship with God through more prolonged, intimate prayers. So, although not essential all the time, regular comprehensive prayers do matter. David suggests that the secret of a close relationship with God is to pray with expectation each morning (Psalm 5:1-3). That is how we put the evil forces on notice that we will not allow the circumstances of the day to deter us.





When we connect with God in prayer, we are inviting the CEO of the known Universes into our dominion to bring life out of death, light out of darkness, motivation and a change in our circumstances. We are inviting the sovereign God of the uni- verse to intervene in the affairs of all men. The more we see life through God's eyesight, the more we should desire to approach the throne of grace in reverent prayer. One characteristic of Jesus' earthly ministry was His desire to be alone with His Father. We see it repeatedly in the Gospels. In that manner, Jesus frequently separated Himself from the crowd to pray. Jesus prayed drops of blood in the Garden of Gethsemane so that God's desires get accomplished.

When I pray, most of my praying contains the desires of my heart (a shopping list) and have often considered little of the heart of God. In prayer, I often approach God with a whole lot of personal pronouns, as if God did not have a good plan for His Kingdom. Despite the great celestial things God has already done without me, most of my praying has primarily been about counseling God, advising God, telling God, correcting God, suggesting things to God, drawing diagrams for God, and reviewing things with God. Have you had any similar experiences in prayer? Prayer may not always change our circumstances; prayer does change our perspective in the circumstances - knowing that our Heavenly Father always has a purpose and His purposes and plan will prevail through any circumstance throughout the universe.

Often our focus is on the great act, the great adventure or the great event we are starting. However, like Jesus, we first need to be a **people of prayer**. But it is SO HARD!!!!

"Why should I? I didn't do anything wrong! I was doing what I was supposed to and then this! They did me wrong!! But it is so hard!!!" Sound familiar? As long as we live, there will be offenses and people will do things to us that we don't deserve. Why does God allow this? The truth of the matter is, God never does evil – sin does. The terrible things that happen in our lives are the direct result of an act that occurred in a garden, too many years ago. Since then, God has required us to forgive. Why? Not for Him or for them, but for us!

Hurt, pain, frustration, disrespect, disappointment, anger, et cetera, all stem from two places – sin and pride. When you scrape the bottom of the things that hold us hostage we will always find ourselves. Someone hurt me; someone stole from me; someone wronged me; someone lied on me; someone disrespected me... . While it may be absolute, we have to forgive them in order to get God's best for ourselves. Just when we think no one cares about us or our situation, God does. He is standing in the face of our hurts, waiting to heal and set us free.

Grab your Bible and read Exodus 20:13-17. These scriptures were given to us from God for a reason. God knows when these things occur they are like a mutating plague that infects every generation, consuming EVERYONE in its path. Reckless abandonment causes the innocent, as well as the guilty, hurt and pain. Hurt people hurt people. Most guilty people will justify (justi-lie) their actions through their belief that they are entitled to something or feel that since they had been wronged by someone they have to make someone else feel the pain that they endure. Conversely, those who have been hurt feel like they *need* revenge, either by committing an act or wanting to ensure the offender pays. Either way, the hurt, hurt.

As Christians, we cannot afford to give away one more minute of life. Every moment spent thinking about the offense is a moment of brain activity that should have been dedicated to something positive and productive for the Kingdom! Moments spent plotting and planning the demise of our offenders is like saying "God, I got this ... You can't handle this

... My will is more righteous than yours ... I can dispense justice better than you, after all you don't know how much ..."

Genesis 27 tells of two brothers, one of whom was clearly offended by the actions of his brother and his mother. There is no doubt that he had been wronged because his future was stolen. His family violated trust, coveted, lied and stole his stuff. They DID HIM WRONG! When he found out what happened, he asked his father to right the wrong. Essentially, Isaac told Esau that he could not change the things that had been set in motion but he gave Esau the power to decide how long he would have to hurt. His father's words to him are as efficacious today as they were then. In the latter portion of verse 40, Isaac told his son, "But when you decide to break free, you will shake his yoke from your neck."(NLT)

Our Heavenly Father has given us promises of a life in Him that is unimaginable. This is truth! While He cannot undo the things that have happened to us, He has given us the power to escape the hurt, pain and disappointment that offense brings. Forgiveness is the decision to break free and stop giving pain rule over our lives. By forgiving, we break the yoke and the shackles of offense AND we are set free! Imagine a mountain in your path. It is high and wide and made up of offenses. You can expend all of your energy trying to climb it, go around it or hoping it would just move. Now imagine forgiveness being like an atomic bomb. Once you set it off, that mountain will be reduced to rubble. The remnants of a thing are easier to get over than the behemoth the thing once was. Like Esau, you have been given the power! Forgive and be free!

Forgiveness is becoming elusive, and while still very necessary to being forgiven, too many couples are willing to quit the marriage rather than forgive their spouses. Many can forgive the offenses of strangers and people to whom they have no real connection, but if our spouse hurts us, we determine their offense to be unforgivable and so bad; they will have to hear about it for the rest of their lives. I am not naïve ... the hurts in marriage can run deep and cause significant damage; but I submit that the hurt we feel is because the love is so real. Again, pride is at the helm of the hurt. We cannot believe that someone who is supposed to love us would hurt us. "He made me look like

a fool." "She made a fool of me." "He lied and broke my trust." "She betrayed me and broke my heart." These are real feelings, as is the hurt. The question is: how do we get past the hurt? There is no quick and easy fix ... **BUT there is a fix**

In John 8:6, Jesus says: "He who is without sin, cast the first stone!" If you have never done anything wrong, go ahead and chuck it. Before you do, think long and hard. You may be able to justify (justi-lie) that you've not done anything wrong in the marriage, but Jesus said the one without sin can call out the others. When Adam and Eve sinned, they only committed one ... disobedience; but that one sin opened the door to countless others! God is not counting sin, one is like a thousand and a thousand is like one! When Jesus hung from the cross, He asked the Father to forgive the world of its sin, collective and

individual. It is by the actions of one, many were sentenced to death AND by the action of One, we are saved and forgiven.

My husband and I have grown to a place where we have decided that forgiveness is not an option. In order to live the best life God has ordained for us, we choose to make forgiveness the order of the day. Now, I won't lie but honestly it was to live in unforgiveness. Sleepless nights, agitated spirits, suspicion and mistrust took its toll on the physical, mental, emotional and our spiritual lives. We

decided that pleasing God was more important than self-satisfaction, so we tried hard to think of Jesus first and then each other before self. When offense comes, we decide if it will affect the sun rising the next day. If it has no power over the rising sun, we have power over it. Elder and I are not "Livin' La Vida Loca" (the crazy life), rather we are living Philippians 3:12-14.

God has the grace and the tools you need to forgive and move forward. Bearing unforgiveness is hard, but unforgiveness in marriage is so much harder! Luke 7:47 (AMP) "Therefore I tell you, her sins, many [as they are], are forgiven her - because she has loved much. But he who is forgiven little loves little."

For men and women, September has important cancer reminders: It's National Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. September is also Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month.



Prostate cancer is the most common cancer among men in the United States after skin cancer. More than 217,730 new cases occur annually usually in men over age 65. Roughly 32,040 deaths per year are caused by this disease. However, the good news is that early detection before the cancer has spread yields a survival rate of near 100 percent, and more than 90 percent of prostate cancers are detected at this local stage.

Risk factors include:

- being over 50 years old,
- being African-American and
- having a close relative with prostate cancer.

Health-care providers recommend being alert to possible symptoms such as:

- Any changes in urinary habits
- Need to urinate frequently, especially at night
- Sense of urgency to urinate but difficulty starting
- Painful urination
- Inability to urinate or weak or interrupted flow
- Continuing pain in the lower back, pelvis or upper thighs.
- Annual screenings to begin at age 50 include a prostate-specific antigen test and an annual digital rectal exam by your health-care provider. Men at higher risk should talk to their doctor about beginning these tests at age 45.

Ovarian cancer remains one of the most difficult cancers to detect. By the time symptoms appear, ovarian cancer is often in an advanced stage and most patients usually do not live long after diagnosis. As a result, few studies have been able to identify lifestyle habits or screenings that can prevent ovarian cancer or detect it early enough to treat successfully.

According to the National Cancer Institute, in the United States, ovarian cancer is the fifth leading cause of cancer death in women and the leading cause of death from cancer of the female reproductive system. Risk factors for ovarian cancer include the following:

- Being older
- Having a family history of ovarian cancer
- Taking hormone replacement therapy after menopause
- Using fertility drugs
- Having increased blood levels of cancer antigen 125
- Being obese
- Having certain hereditary conditions (such as hereditary nonpolyposis colon cancer, also called Lynch Syndrome)

There are some factors that seem to decrease a woman's risk of developing ovarian cancer. Women who have done the following seem to have a lower than average risk of developing ovarian cancer:

- taken oral contraceptives
- given birth
- breast-fed
- have had a tubal ligation or hysterectomy

Currently, there is no standard or routine screening test for ovarian cancer. Still, the best advice is to be cautious especially if you have a family history of this disease. Stick to AICR's Guidelines for Cancer Prevention.

Among all the cancers of the female reproductive system, endometrial cancer (the lining of the uterus) is most clearly linked to extra body fat. AICR's policy report found that 70 percent of endometrial cancers could be prevented if all women ate a healthy diet, got at least 30 minutes of physical activity each day and maintained a healthy body weight. Excess body fat was independently linked to 49 percent of endometrial cancers (20,700 cases per year), according to the report.

The Bottom Line for Overall Cancer Prevention

AICR's Guidelines for Cancer Prevention are:

1. Choose mostly plant foods (vegetables, fruits, whole grains and beans), limit red meat and avoid processed meat.
2. Be physically active every day in any way for 30 minutes or more
3. Aim to be a healthy weight throughout life
4. And always remember—do not smoke or chew tobacco

This healthy diet of mostly plant-based foods provides cancer-fighting phytochemicals and vitamins along with health-protecting

Students in grades Kindergarten through High School—Students with special needs, College and Adult students are all welcomed.

The Center reveals a comfortable study room, with full service technology including 6 computers equipped with Windows XP & Microsoft Office. Various text books, manuals, and study guides for higher learning are also available. GED, FCAT, ACT, SAT, GRE.

The tutors are all passionate volunteers, some are currently teaching, retired teachers, or studying to be teachers. Others are past CLC students, business professionals who are using their expertise in academic subjects to help the children of our community. All are committed to enhancing academic skills and changing poor study habits; but also increasing self esteem, providing support and encouragement that breeds success and

sparks a cycle of confidence that empowers the student to become all that He has created them to be.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Is the CLC only for only students who are having difficulties in school.

A: No, our tutors can help bring a child up to speed if they are below grade level but most students regardless of their academic performance can use extra help with organizational and study skills. The CLC has numerous testimonials of "status quo" students who are now at the top of their class and report higher grades in all subject areas.

Q: Is there a Fee or Tuition?

A: No there is no charge for tutoring. However every student is required to make a "Each one, Teach One" Pledge which demands that each student share the valuable information freely given to them with someone who lacks such skills and is less fortunate.

Q: Are sessions customized for students?

A: Guidelines are created after initial assessment of current work and curriculum. Working together with the parents and the student, the Learning Center can help a student excel at the next level.


AWESOME STARTS WITH OBEDIENCE


1. Recognize/Admit That You Are a Sinner,




